

The Deanery of Jersey: Fees for Occasional Services 2020

Baptism

There is no fee for a Baptism service. A nominal fee of £15 may be charged for the production of a Baptism certificate, should the family request one.

Other fees (Organist, choir, bells, video etc) by arrangement*

*£220 assigned to Deanery, £220 for Church if Parishioner (£320 if non-parishioner)
If visiting SSM or retired Clergy take a wedding, they receive the Deanery assigned £220 fee.
Travel fee per Deanery mileage rate charged to Church*

Marriage of Parishioners by Banns or Licence in District Church

Publication of Banns (payable to local church)	£30
Certificate of Banns	£15
Licence	£85
Ministry	£440
Charge for use of District Church	£200
Administration	£50
Verger (if required)	£50

*Any subsequent certificate of Marriage to be obtained from Registrar
Other fees (Organist, choir, bells, video etc) by arrangement*

*£220 assigned to Deanery. £220 for Church (or £420 if non parishioner)
If visiting SSM or retired Clergy take a wedding, they receive the Deanery assigned £220 fee.
Travel fee per Deanery mileage rate charged to Church*

Canon B37.2 No minister shall refuse to bury, according to the rites of the Church of England, the corpse or ashes of any person deceased within his cure or of any parishioners whether deceased within his cure or elsewhere that is brought to a church or burial ground or cemetery under his control in which the burial or interment of such corpse or ashes may lawfully be effected, due notice being given.
